Potholes fixed on the council roading network between 2012 and 2023

Thank you for your request made under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (the Act), received on 24 May 2023. You requested the following information:

- The number of potholes that Wellington City Council has fixed on our roading network, broken down by each calendar year, for the period 2012 to 2023.

Wellington City Council has granted your request for information.

Please note the below data is variable due to many factors. Potholes are reactive maintenance and are reported by our customers, contractors or Council staff. Contractors are also able to fix potholes they come across without prior approval from the Council. Where there are multiple potholes on a single road, we may resurface the affected area instead of doing multiple repairs. If there are potholes fixed by resurfacing, these are not included in the figures in the below table.
